Registration, a Director's Meeting, and Auditions will be held at Seton Hill University's Performing Arts Center (100 Harrison Ave. - Located on the "lower campus") on Thursday, December 9, 2021 starting at 5pm—please review the attached schedule for specific times and locations. Upon arrival you can park in either the Kern's lot (except in spots marked "24/7") and in lot 131. Please enter through the Harrison Ave. doors (under the big green marquee) where you will find our registration table. Remind your students to bring \$5.00 for the audition as well as monies if they would like to purchase pizza and snacks. Food will be provided for the directors. Directors are also reminded they must be in attendance to assist with auditions.

The two-day festival will run on Friday, February 4th, 2022 from 9:00am – 4:00pm and Saturday, February 5th from 9:00am – 4:00pm, followed by the concert at 5:30pm. Please remind your students to check their availability for both days of the festival. Our two guest directors are: Mr. Joe Sheller, music educator at Kiski M.S. and freelance jazz musician and Mr. Clint Bleil, composer freelance saxophonist, and Visiting Assistant Professor of

musician and Mr. Clint Bleil, composer, freelance saxophonist, and Visiting Assistant Professor of Music at Washington and Jefferson College.
