NEW DISTRICT BAND SELECTION/AUDITION PROCEDURES BEGIN FALL 2020

Over the past several years, there have been many discussions about revising the selection process for District Band. A committee was created and tasked with researching & discussing possible changes, examining the advantages and disadvantages of changing the selection process, and, ultimately, developing a proposal for a new selection process to bring before the directors of District 1. The proposal was presented at the 2020 District Band Festival, discussed, and voted upon by the membership for implementation in the 2020-2021 school year. The most significant change is that ALL students that would like to be considered for selection into District Band (grades 10-12), Honors Band (grades 9-12), and District Orchestra (winds/percussion grades 10-12) **MUST complete an audition** on the District 1 Band Audition Day. Additionally, in order to make the audition more accessible for all students, a group of District 1 directors reviewed the music in the current audition cycle for the 2020-2021 school year and made reductions to the amount of music that needs to be prepared for the audition, ensuring that the material is musically relevant and developmentally appropriate. The updated audition material for the 2020-2021 school year is reflected in the grid below. General Information:

- 1. The District 1 Band Audition Day will be the first Monday of October. *Please note: In response to anticipated restrictions due to Covid-19, the Executive Committee for District 1 has decided that all auditions scheduled to take place in the fall of 2020, will be completed via Submittable. More information regarding the timeline for submissions will be shared at a later date.*
- 2. Each school represented at the auditions will be guaranteed one student in District Band.
